Introduction

Every child should be able to travel to school in a healthy, sustainable and safe way. By working together with our children's parents/carers and neighbours we aim to promote this documenting it in our travel plan

Our school is situated in a beautiful rural village of Woodbury Salterton, surrounded by countryside, but just 10 minutes' drive from the outskirts of Exmouth, 12 minutes from Clyst Heath, Exeter and 10 minutes from Topsham. The building is located in the heart of the village adjacent to the church on a junction. The school has a travel plan to encourage healthy active travel to school, improving local air quality, improving road safety and congestion at the school gates, reducing the school's carbon footprint

School travel plan aims

To promote safe healthy and sustainable travel to school including

- promotion of healthy life style
- Protection of environment with reference to sustainable travel
- Safe way to travel to school

School objectives

Promote road safety

To link healthy life style to how children travel to and from school

To understand how the individual can protect the environment by their choice of travel method

Encourage walking, cycling, car share and use of park and stride where possible

Reduce congestion round school gate during start and end of school day

As a school we will

We will support and encourage the use of the car park the Diggers Rest at the start and finish of the school day

We will support and encourage the use of car sharing

We will advertise car sharing contact system on web site

We will advertise park and stride on web page

We will inform visitors of suitable places to park

Head teacher/Head of Learning assembly once a term will promote car share and parking at Diggers Rest

The school will have an annual focus on health travel (e.g. healthy travel day / week)

Safe parking will be in the home school agreement

The school will host cycle training

Road safety training will be included in the curriculum

Promotion of healthy life styles will be included in the curriculum

Understanding of protecting the environment and sustainable travel will be included in the curriculum

The school will actively support breakfast club + afterschool clubs to reduce numbers of travellers at start and end of school day

Head teacher and Senior Leadership Team will work closely with police and road safety officer

School newsletter will promote car sharing or parking in the Digger's rest at least half termly

The school will ensure any new book bags sold by the school have a reflective strip on

The school will maintain close links with the church to encourage children to walk though church yard

Travel plan will be reviewed by governors annually

As a parent we will

Drive safely

Park cars away from the school entrance and junction when dropping off and picking up children

Be courteous to our neighbours

Park at the Digger's Rest

Avoid blocking our neighbours driveways
